STERILIZATION: We recommend that your pet is sterilized before the age of 6 months. Additional surgical fees may be applicable if your pet is over 6 months of age, if your cat is over 15 lbs or if your dog is over 60 lbs at the time of surgery. Blood testing is performed at the time of the procedure to ensure that your pet is healthy enough to undergo the procedure and anesthesia. Blood abnormalities may require postponing the procedure. You will be responsible for the cost of any additional blood panels outside the program needed to ensure that blood abnormalities have been resolved.

PLAN CANCELLATION: All wellness program services are sold as a bundle at steep discounts under annual contract divided into payments. Wellness programs can be cancelled at any time. If a program is cancelled before the end of its term for any reason you are responsible for any remaining payments or the full retail value of services and discounts provided to you under the plan, whichever is less.
